Purpose

To provide an overview of results achieved by the Departments of Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada (CIRNAC) and Indigenous Services Canada (ISC) for the 2021-2022 fiscal year under the *Access to Information Act* and *Privacy Act*

As required by the Acts, these reports and results were tabled in Parliament on October 7, 2022





Legislated Responsibilities

- The *Access to Information Act (ATIA)* provides a right of access to government records, and requires proactive publication of key information.
- The *Privacy Act (PA)* provides individuals with a right of access to their own personal information held by government; and sets out rules governing the collection, retention, use and disclosure of personal information by a federal institution.
- The Office of the Information Commissioner and the Office of the Privacy Commissioner
 - Provides oversight and monitors federal institutions' performances under the ATIA and PA
 - Carries out investigations and dispute-resolution efforts to resolve complaints





The ATIP Directorate provides a shared service to both CIRNAC and ISC
