Scanning of the microfilm was outsourced to a local document imaging company

Scanning started in March 2018 and was completed in March 2019


Format of film – 35mm negatives

Resolution of initial scans – 600DPI


Access format – multi-page PDFs

Level of compression was considered in the process of converting the files, taking into account that the records are all pre-1870 and in various styles of cursive writing.


Abitibi post journal, 1794-1796




Fort Victoria correspondence book, 1866-1868




lle-a-la-Crosse general account book, 1828-1829



Thompson's River District report, 1827













